PRE-CONFIGURATION

There are no preconfiguration requirements. When you visit the Elluminate website via the web link listed above, Java software will be downloaded into your machine. It is a good idea to visit the Elluminate link to access the site at least a day or two before the press conference to make certain there are not any unforeseen technology configuration needs. Usually, access is seamless and pain free. It is as simple as clicking on the link. You can email questions to Will Richardson at will@plpnetwork.com.

You will need speakers or earphones to listen to the conversation. If you wish to participate, you need to have a microphone as well.
